



Forming Learning Independence Through Training On The Use Of Canva In Making *E-Books* As A Learning Medium For Ppkn In The Independent Curriculum

This study aims to describe the training on the use of canva in creating e-books as a learning media for Pancasila and Civics Education (PPKn) in the Merdeka Curriculum to develop students' independent learning skills. The study used a qualitative descriptive method with data collection techniques through observation, interviews, and documentation.
